All Voting Delegates must bring their credentials to register. All proxies must complete the proper form prior to attending Grand Session and present it at Credentials Registration.

Housing Reservations: Reservations may be made directly with the Hotel, please reference the Job's Daughters block. Room cost is \$105.00. Cut-off date is **April 18th, 2022.**

Fees - in accordance with Article V1, Sec 2(a) By-Laws GGC:
All persons attending Grand Session must pay a \$5.00 Registration Fee.
All adults must pay a \$20.00 Session Fee in addition to the Registration Fee.
Voting Delegates shall pay an annual Membership Fee of \$10.00, if this has not already been paid, you will need to do so before your voting card will be issued.

Medical Forms: Do not send medical forms with reservation. Medical Forms must be turned in at Registration before you receive your packet. Please pick them up before you leave Session.

Chaperones: There must be one (1) Certified Adult Volunteer (CAV) for every five (5) Daughters. Voting delegates should NOT be asked to Chaperone since they are expected to attend all business meetings. Chaperones will be responsible for the conduct and appearance of the Daughters of their Bethel. Job's Daughters as well as adults should conduct themselves at all times as to be a credit to our order.

Attire: Dresses or skirts are required for Daughters and Ladies for all meetings. Business suits or dress slacks with collared sport shirt, sweater or jacket are required for the Gentlemen for all meetings. Formal attire is requested for the Formal Opening and Installation. Spirit wear shirts with skirts and dress slacks may be worn for the Friday afternoon business meeting. Rehearsals are casual- please no abbreviated attire or "grubbies." Shoes are required at all times.

Reports: All Committee, Competition, and Grand Officer reports are due before Grand Session. This year we will again be requesting reports be submitted in advance so we may distribute to all GGC Members in advance of Session. We are asking that you submit your report to the Grand Guardian by **May 1st**. These reports will be put together and distributed via e-mail to each of the GGC Members. If there is a change to your report before Grand Session, you may submit that new, final report by Saturday, May 7th so it is included in the proceedings from the Session. Please be sure that your report includes detailed information on how things went this year as well as any details that future committee members may find helpful.
